

# Newham London *Run2011*

## Sunday 27 March 2011

### Dear Resident/Business occupier

This year's Newham London Run will take place on the morning of Sunday 27 March. This is the second staging of the event which will see runners of all ages taking part in the day's events. The Newham London Run will see, following the 10km run, a Junior run starting and finishing on Angel Lane taking runners into Stratford City.

A number of roads within Newham, in particular the Stratford area, will be affected by this event, with road closure and traffic diversion plans in operation on the day. Warning notices will be put up 10 days beforehand on the key routes – a copy of the run route is attached overleaf. The Newham London Run will start on Angel Lane and finish on Densham Road.

**The following roads will be closed from 04:30 on Sunday 27 March:** To build the start and finish areas respectively. For the start, Angel Lane from Cobham Lane to Great Eastern Rd and for the finish Densham Road between Vicarage Lane and West Ham Lane. This will mean that no traffic will be able to access Angel Lane from Leyton Rd or Great Eastern Rd Or West Ham Lane from Portway – diversions will be in operation on the day.

**The following roads will be closed from 08:00 on Sunday 27 March:** To allow for the course to be set up ready for the run starts. This will include: Warton Rd; Marshgate Lane from High St to Pudding Mill Lane train station; Canning Road from the industrial units at the west end to Abbey Road; Abbey Road from Canning Road to New Plaistow Road and Portway from Densham Rd to Upton Lane.

**The following roads will be closed at 09:00 on Sunday 27 March:** To allow for the remainder of the course to be set up ready for the run starts. New Plaistow Road from Manor Road to West Ham Lane; West Ham Lane from New Plaistow Road to High Street and Tramway from Broadway to West Ham Lane. Aldworth Rd; Mark St; Victoria St; Barnaby St; Paul St; and Pitchford St. Please note – that vehicles will be permitted to leave this area but not return until West Ham Lane is reopened (please see reopenings below). High Street ON slip road from the Blackwall Tunnel northern approach roundabout to High Street; High Street OFF slip from High Street to Blackwall Tunnel northern approach roundabout; Abbey Lane from Abbey lane to High Street; Sugar House Lane from Sugar House Lane to High Street; Meesons Wharf from Meesons Wharf (both junctions) to High St OFF slip road.

**Residents living directly on, or with secured parking off, any of the above roads who will need to use their vehicle on the morning of**

**Sunday 27 March should use alternative parking away from those roads affected by the road closures.**

Event stewards and course management will assist traffic and residents wherever possible on the day of the race, allowing cars access to and from properties within the road closures whenever it is safe to do so and up until 09:00. Please note that for safety reasons there can be no access onto the course after this time.

We will endeavour to re open roads as soon as possible – there is a structured plan in place to do this after the runners have passed through a section of course and the event infrastructure has been removed.

**The following roads will reopen from 11:30 on Sunday 27 March:** Warton Rd; Marshgate Lane; Pudding Mill Lane.

**The following roads will reopen from 12:00 on Sunday 27 March:** High Street ON slip from Blackwall Tunnel northern approach roundabout (eastbound).

**The following roads will reopen from 12:30 on Sunday 27 March:** High St OFF slip leading to Blackwall Tunnel northern approach roundabout (westbound); Sugar House Lane, Hurts Lane and Abbey Lane. Canning Rd; Abbey Rd; New Plaistow Rd and West Ham Lane.

**The following roads will reopen from 13:00 on Sunday 27 March:** Portway from Vicarage Lane to Upton Lane.

**The following roads will reopen from 13:00 on Sunday 27 March:** Angel Lane from Great Eastern Rd to Cobham St.

**The following roads will reopen from 14:00 on Sunday 27 March:** Densham Road from Vicarage Lane to West Ham Lane.

**Please note that there will also be a Mandatory speed limit of 10mph in operation on the east and west bound High Street from Broadway to the Bow Church junction.**

**Parking restrictions in place for the event will be imposed from 20:00 Saturday 26 March until 14:00 Sunday 27 March on the following streets:** Abbey Road from Mitre Road to New Plaistow Road; Densham Road from West Ham Lane to Vicarage Road; Portway from Vicarage Lane to Geere Road and Marshgate Lane from High Street to Pudding Mill Lane train station. Warton Rd; High St ON slip from Blackwall Tunnel northern approach roundabout to High Street.

**We apologise for any inconvenience that this event may cause you. Full traffic diversion signage, approved by Police and the relevant local authorities will be in place across all the areas affected by the road closures.**

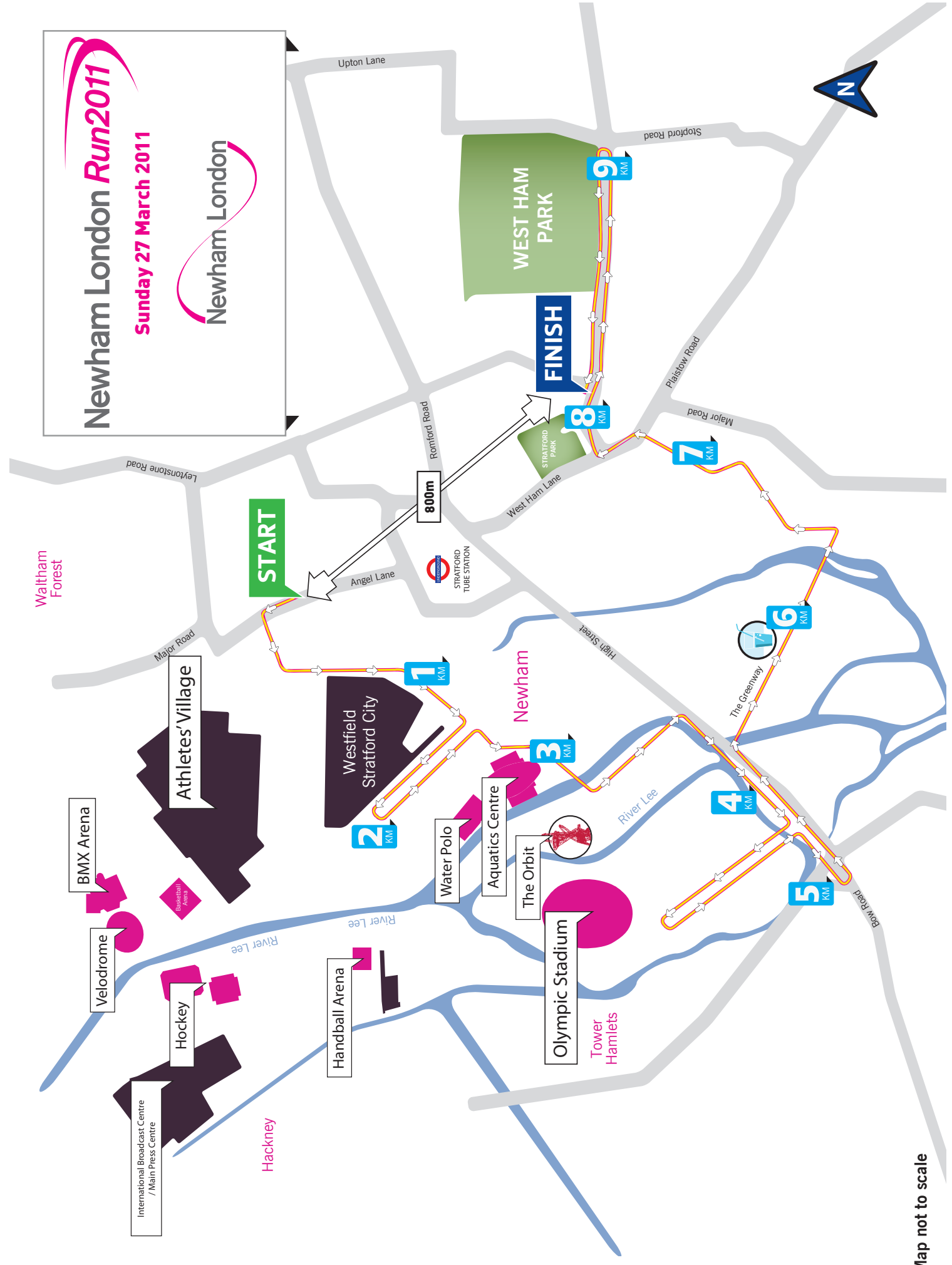
